

LAW ENFORCEMENT TRESPASSING AFFIDAVIT

Law enforcement agencies seek assistance from property owners in enforcing Utah Code 76-6-206 ("the Criminal Trespass statute"). Law enforcement agencies have found this beneficial for the property owners and law enforcement efforts because it reduces problems with vandalism, littering, public intoxication, illicit drug use, prostitution, harassment, assault, and other related problems. A signed affidavit from the property owner along with the posting of approved "No Trespassing" signs will enable law enforcement agencies to enforce the law on properties with restricted access, during non-business hours, or in other instances where property owners have indicated an intent to trespass individuals who are no longer welcome on premises. During regular business hours, the sign(s) will enable both the responsible parties and law enforcement agencies to use the law more effectively in reducing crime and other related problems. The sign(s) must be visibly posted and maintained. An electronic copy of the affidavit will be maintained by law enforcement agencies for enforcement and court purposes.
