FEBRUARY 2020- PART I & II OFFENSE PERCENTAGES



MARCH 2020- PART I & II OFFENSE PERCENTAGES




APRIL 2020- PART I & II OFFENSE PERCENTAGES





MAY 2020- PART I & II OFFENSE PERCENTAGES




JUNE 2020 - PART I & II OFFENSE PERCENTAGES

MAY 2020- PART I & II OFFENSE PERCENTAGES


