
#### **MARCH 2020- PART I & II OFFENSE PERCENTAGES**


### **APRIL 2020- PART I & II OFFENSE PERCENTAGES**






#### JUNE 2020 - PART I & II OFFENSE PERCENTAGES


### **DECEMBER 2020- PART I & II OFFENSE PERCENTAGES**






