




JANUARY 2022 - COMPSTAT AND EXTENDED COMPSTAT OFFENSE PERCENTAGES



FEBRUARY 2022 - COMPSTAT AND EXTENDED COMPSTAT OFFENSE PERCENTAGES






Extended CompStat Offenses














Extended CompStat Offenses






MAY 2022 - COMPSTAT AND EXTENDED COMPSTAT OFFENSE PERCENTAGES


SEPTEMBER 2022 - COMPSTAT AND EXTENDED COMPSTAT OFFENSE PERCENTAGES
