




JANUARY 2022 - COMPSTAT AND EXTENDED COMPSTAT OFFENSE PERCENTAGES


FEBRUARY 2022 - COMPSTAT AND EXTENDED COMPSTAT OFFENSE PERCENTAGES







MARCH 2022 - COMPSTAT AND EXTENDED COMPSTAT OFFENSE PERCENTAGES







OCTOBER 2022 - COMPSTAT AND EXTENDED COMPSTAT OFFENSE PERCENTAGES




DECEMBER 2022 - COMPSTAT AND EXTENDED COMPSTAT OFFENSE PERCENTAGES
